## Saturday 8th June Plant Sale at Pencoed College


We have been invited to have a plant stall at Pencoed College. (Pencoed Campus, Pencoed, CF35 5LG) Sale is from 1000-1400.

Stockton Bury is a four acre garden which is the Treasure's family home and business in the heart of a working farm originally one of the Bury Farm of the Benedictine Priory in Leominster with a dovecote and mediaeval barns.
