INSTRUCTIONS FOR ORDERING SEED FROM THE UK

Please read carefully before ordering.

1. ALLOCATION:

- Up to 20 packets per person. Joint members: 20 packets each. Order on separate forms.
- Donors of five or more different varieties of seed: 15 extra packets.

2. ON YOUR ORDER FORM:

- Complete all relevant boxes, including name and address.
- Enter choices in seed list number order. Not doing so will incur a delay in processing.
- (Donors, this means up to 30 numbers, all in seed list order).
- No repeat numbers please. Joint members: please do not duplicate orders.
- To receive your full allocation, please list substitutes.
- **Pot luck substitute** (our choice of named seed) can be requested as a substitute to make up your order.
- Tick **Seed Mix** box to receive an extra packet of escaped or insufficiently labelled seed.
- Enter number of **Random Sets** (each contain 25 randomly picked packets of seed). Cost is £2.50 per set. These will be selected from remaining seed and despatched after all orders are completed.

3. ADMIN CHARGE:

- £5.00 (plus £2.50 per Random Set)
- For details of payment methods please see the order form on the back page.

4. POSTING:

- Please send your order in a regular 'letter size' envelope (no larger than this page). Using a larger envelope incurs a Post Office surcharge, considerable extra administrator's time and a delay in processing your order.
- Please **do not** send a stamped self-addressed envelope for order return.

CLOSING DATE FOR RECEIPT OF ORDERS: 5th January 2024

All orders will be processed in order of receipt and dispatched by end of first week of March 2024

Compliance with the Rio Convention on Biological diversity and the Nagoya Protocol.

HPS request that seed donors who collect seed from the wild observe the laws of the source country. To the best of our knowledge no seed in this list has been acquired illegally, nor has any seed been collected which contravenes the Nagoya Protocol. The Nagoya Protocol forbids the utilisation of genetic material (including seed) which has been collected in the wild from signatory countries, for the development of new named cultivars and hybrids, or new drugs and other products, without a written contract with the country of origin.

EXPLANATORY NOTES — SEED LIST 2024

- 1. Coming true from seed:** please be aware that seed from cultivars, e.g. Aconitum ‘Bressingham Spire’, **will not be identical to the parent and plants from such seed should never be labelled with the parent cultivar name.** Also, some plants are highly promiscuous, and seedlings may be very different from the parent. It is very important such plants do not enter the nursery trade with the parent plant’s name as this causes confusion. Enjoy growing plants from these HPS seeds, but remember that variation will occur and label plants as ‘ex...’. Also remember that species plants naturally show some degree of variation and ‘sports’ arise this way.
- 2. #** Indicates seed from a plant usually considered sterile. **!** Indicates the plant is known to be hazardous.
- 3. Ferns:** for growing tips see HPS Journal, October 2011, (p. 25-31) or The British Pteridological Society website www.ebps.org.uk See also the HPS publication on Ferns, by Neil Timm. ISBN 978-0-901687-31-9
- 4. The Mix:** An unnamed mix of seed which has ‘escaped’, or cannot be verified. This is an optional extra which often produces interesting plants.
- 5. Pot Luck substitute.** Our choice of named seed which can be requested as a substitute should a first choice be unavailable.
- 6. Random Sets.** These are Sets of 25 packets of seed picked at random after all orders have been completed. Enter the number of Random Sets required on the order form and add £2.50 per **Set** to your payment.
- 7. Seed Donors please note:** If your seed does not appear in the list: the name may have changed (see acknowledgement below); we could not identify the name in the Plant Finder or on the internet nor find a reliable name matching your description and seed has been put into the Mix; there was too little seed to pack separately and it has been added to a relevant group; the packet when checked did not contain viable seed; we could not read your writing; or seed arrived after the closing date and has been included in ‘Pot Luck substitutes’ or stored until next year.

Aquilegias. Some U.K. aquilegias are showing signs of Downy Mildew. Please observe aquilegias in your garden and keep an eye on any seedlings you grow.

EXPLANATORY NOTES — SEED LIST 2024

1. **Phyto-sanitary requirements.** Please be aware that some governments insist that seed entering their country has specific certification. Anyone ordering HPS seed is responsible for ensuring that their national requirements are followed and that any necessary compliance documents and instructions are included along with the seed order.
2. **Coming true from seed:** please be aware that seed from cultivars, e.g. Aconitum ‘Bressingham Spire’, **will not be identical to the parent and plants from such seed should never be labelled with the parent cultivar name.** Also, some plants are highly promiscuous, and seedlings may be very different from the parent. It is very important such plants do not enter the nursery trade with the parent plant’s name as this causes confusion. Enjoy growing plants from these HPS seeds, but remember that variation will occur and label plants as ‘ex...’. Also remember that species plants naturally show some degree of variation and ‘sports’ arise this way.
3. # Indicates seed from a plant usually considered sterile. ! Indicates the plant is known to be hazardous.
4. **Ferns:** for growing tips see HPS Journal, October 2011, (p. 25-31) or The British Pteridological Society website www.ebps.org.uk See also the HPS publication on Ferns, by Neil Timm. ISBN 978-0-901687-31-9
5. **Seed Donors please note:** If your seed does not appear in the list: the name may have changed (see acknowledgement below); we could not identify the name in the Plant Finder or on the internet nor find a reliable name matching your description and seed has been put into the Mix; there was too little seed to pack separately and it has been added to a relevant group; the packet when checked did not contain viable seed; we could not read your writing; or seed arrived after the closing date and has been stored until next year.

Aquilegias. We regret that we will not be able to send any Aquilegia seed overseas again this year. Some U.K. aquilegias are showing signs of Downy Mildew and we cannot yet guarantee that it cannot be spread by seed.
